Separate sealed Bids will be received until 2:00 pm, Wednesday April 29, 2026, in the Town of Edenton Municipal Office at 400 Broad Street, Edenton, N.C., at which time and place bids will be publicly opened and read aloud for the construction of the Paradise Road Waterline Extension.

After Bids are opened, the Owner shall evaluate them in accordance with the methods and criteria set forth in the Instructions to Bidders. The Owner reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject any or all Bids. Unless all Bids are rejected, Award will be made to the lowest responsible Bidder, taking into consideration quality, performance and the time specified in the proposals for the performance of the Contract.

The Project consists of the following major items:

- 2,800 LF of New 8-inch C-900 PVC Water Main;
- 1 New Fire Hydrant Assembly;
- 450 SY of Clearing and Grubbing;
- 15 LF of New 24-inch Corrugated Plastic Pipe with New 24-inch Flared-In Section;
- Miscellaneous Appurtenances (Erosion Control, Tapping Sleeve & Valve, Reducer, etc.).
