Bids for the construction of the Project will be received at the Nash County – Claude Mayo Junior Administrative Building – 3rd Floor, Suite 3072 located at 120 West Washington Street, Suite 3072, Nashville, NC 27856 until Thursday, January 22, 2026 at 2:00 pm local time. At that time, the Bids received will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for Bidding Documents, including addenda, if any, obtained from sources other than the designated website.

Bidders will be required to show evidence that they are licensed to perform the work in the Bidding Documents as required by North Carolina General Statute, Chapter 87 and the Instructions to Bidders.

Bid Security in the amount of five (5) percent of the Bid must accompany each Bid and shall be subject to the conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders.

The Owner is an Equal Opportunity Employer and encourages bidding by small, minority and female contractors and does not discriminate on the basis of handicapped status. Bids from qualified disadvantaged business enterprise (DBE) are encouraged.
